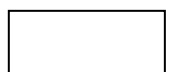

T026/17 Newquay BID update

The Newquay BID Manager gave an update on BID matters. There are plans being put into date for some future events, however, these dates are to be confirmed. The BID Manager felt that St Pirans' went rather well. The funding for the 'I Love Newquay' project had been applied for, with confirmation being received at the end of the week. BID have already published several press releases for 2017 in various media formats., with a further 6 to be printed and finalised. This years edition of Seven has been proofed, with the amendments being made, however, it's hoped that the document will be released before Easter.

Newquay BID are currently 27 likes away from hitting the 25,000 mark on Facebook, with a progression being made in the German Market. The I Love Newquay banners will be going up on the 31st of March, the issues around them ripping should have been resolved now.

It was asked, whether or not, Newquay BID would be able to investigate the "Pop-Up Licenses" that are being issued by Cornwall Council. Cornwall Council have extended the license to include the sale of hot and cold beverages and food. Due to this, a well established organisation has aired their concerns to the Town Council regarding this. It was also stated that established businesses are losing trade, due to Cornwall Council's approval over Street Trading Licences being issued, ignoring the concerns and objections raised by Cornwall Council. The Newquay BID Manager has stated that she would contact Cornwall Council's Licensing Department in order to investigate the matter.

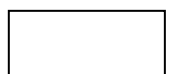

This would have also protected the public from the road.

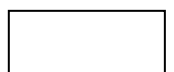
